

Card-Game Tournament

Ages 7–12 · 30–40 min · Small groups

Learning intention

This experience supports children to become aware of fairness and sportsmanship, and to interact with care and respect.

You'll need

- Several decks of cards
- A simple scoreboard

How to do it

1. Teach or revise a simple card game the whole group can play.
2. Set up small tables and rotate players between rounds.
3. Keep a friendly scoreboard, emphasising fun over winning.
4. Talk about good sportsmanship throughout.
