

Cookie-Cutter Stamped Cards

Ages 5-10 · 30 min · Small group

Learning intention

This experience supports children to communicate for a purpose and to show care and empathy for others.

You'll need

- Cookie cutters
- Poster paint
- Thick paper or blank cards
- Glue and beads (optional)

How to do it

1. Children write a message inside the card first.
2. They dip cookie cutters into paint and stamp shapes on the front.
3. Add beads or glitter with glue to decorate.
4. A craft twist on cooking tools - great for occasions and thank-yous.
