

Cupcake-Liner Sea Creatures

Ages 4-9 · 20-30 min · Small group

Learning intention

This experience supports children to use imagination to create and to develop an interest in the natural world.

You'll need

- Cupcake liners
- Coloured paper
- Sticky tape
- Textas

How to do it

1. Children cut coloured paper into thin strips for tentacles.
2. Tape the tentacles under a flattened cupcake liner.
3. Draw a face on the liner to finish the sea creature.
4. A no-bake craft that links to ocean and sea-life themes.
