

Design Your Own Team Jersey

Ages 6–12 · 30 min · Individual

Learning intention

This experience supports children to develop a confident self-identity and to express imagination through design.

You'll need

- Jersey template printouts
- Coloured pencils and textas
- Optional fabric markers and plain shirts

How to do it

1. Talk with children about teams and colours they like.
2. Children design their own jersey on the template, choosing a name, number and pattern.
3. Discuss why teams use particular colours and symbols.
4. Finished designs can decorate the active-play noticeboard.
