

Festive Shortbread

Ages 6–12 · 45 min · Small group

Learning intention

This experience supports children to respect different family traditions and to measure and bake together.

You'll need

- Butter
- Sugar
- Flour
- Cookie cutters
- Decorations

How to do it

1. Children cream the butter and sugar, then mix in the flour.
2. Roll out the dough and cut shapes with cutters.
3. Bake until pale gold.
4. Decorate once cool and talk about family celebrations.
