

Make Your Own Board Game

Ages 7-12 · 40-60 min · Small group

Learning intention

This experience supports children to create and design, and to become aware of fairness when making rules.

You'll need

- Cardboard and boxes
- Markers
- Dice and counters
- Ribbon and string

How to do it

1. Children design and build their own board game from recycled materials.
2. They decide the rules, the goal and how to win.
3. Groups test their game and adjust rules that don't work.
4. Swap games with another group and play.
