

Movie Trailer Making

Ages 8–12 · 40–60 min · Small group

Learning intention

This experience supports children to use digital media to represent their thinking and to collaborate with agency.

You'll need

- Tablets with a video app
- Small props or construction toys
- A quiet filming corner

How to do it

1. Children plan a short movie trailer storyline.
2. They use props or act out scenes themselves.
3. Film short clips on the tablet.
4. Edit the clips together and screen the finished trailers.
