

Music Production on Tablets

Ages 8–12 · 40 min · Small group

Learning intention

This experience supports children to create with digital media and to express creative ideas.

You'll need

- Tablets with a music-making app
- Headphones (optional)

How to do it

1. Show children the basics of a simple music app.
2. Children layer beats, melodies and sounds to compose a track.
3. They listen back and refine their composition.
4. Share the finished tracks with the group.
