

Sock Puppet Show

Ages 5-10 · 40 min · Small group

Learning intention

This experience supports children to communicate for a range of purposes and to build confidence performing.

You'll need

- Clean socks
- Googly eyes
- Wool and felt
- Glue
- A table or box as a stage

How to do it

1. Children make a sock puppet using eyes, wool and felt.
2. In pairs or small groups they plan a short story.
3. Set up a simple stage behind a table or box.
4. Groups perform their puppet show for the rest of the children.
