

Themed Board Game Craft

Ages 6–12 · 40 min · Small group

Learning intention

This experience supports children to express creative ideas and to share their personal interests.

You'll need

- A board game template
- Printed character cut-outs
- Dice
- Scissors, glue, textas

How to do it

1. Children decorate a blank board template in a theme they love.
2. They cut out characters to use as playing pieces.
3. Add a start, finish and simple rules.
4. Play the finished game together.
